





Accomodation



With over 5 million visitors every year, Buenos Aires has no shortage of places to stay, with accommodation catering to every budget and every taste imaginable. Buenos Aires has become a tourist attraction, and hostels, B&Bs, and other residences offer a cozy and attractive atmosphere for students. Prices for beds in a hostel starts at less than $5 \in$. With respect to hotels, the city of Buenos Aires offers today 36,000 bedrooms in all categories.

Average room prices include 21% VAT (deducible) and breakfast.

- Five star and deluxe hotel prices range from 100 € to 470 €.
- Four star hotel prices range from 55 € to 200 €.
