

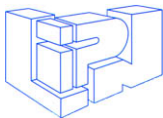

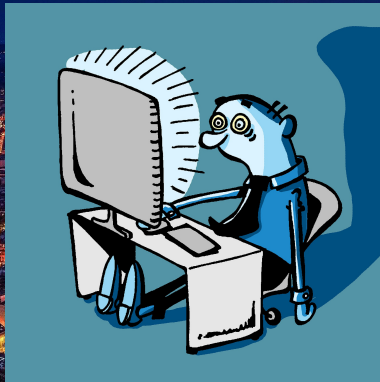

Situation - After Covid-19

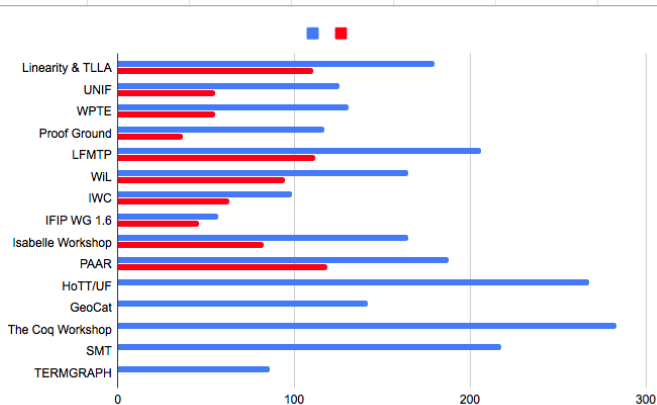
