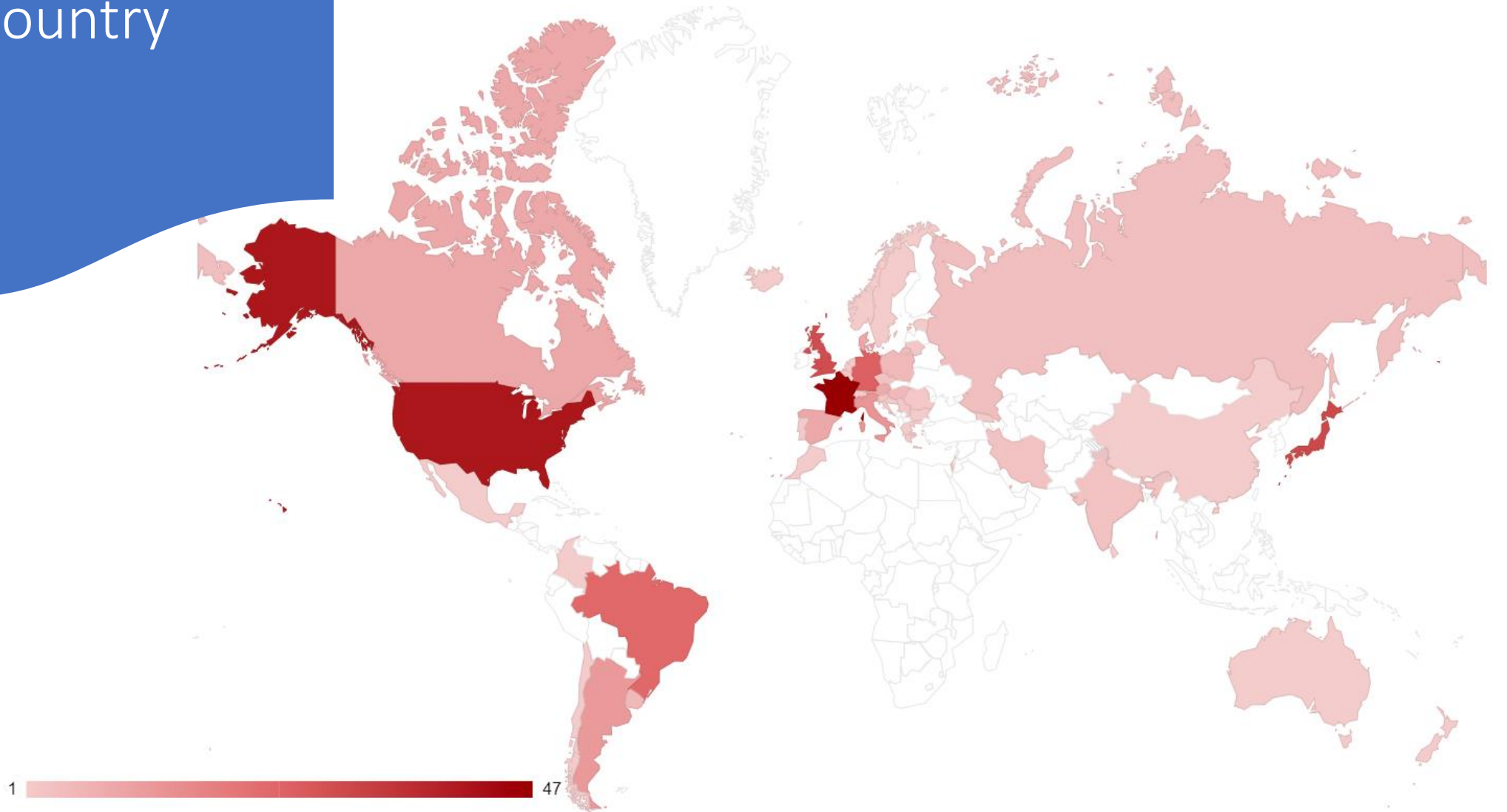

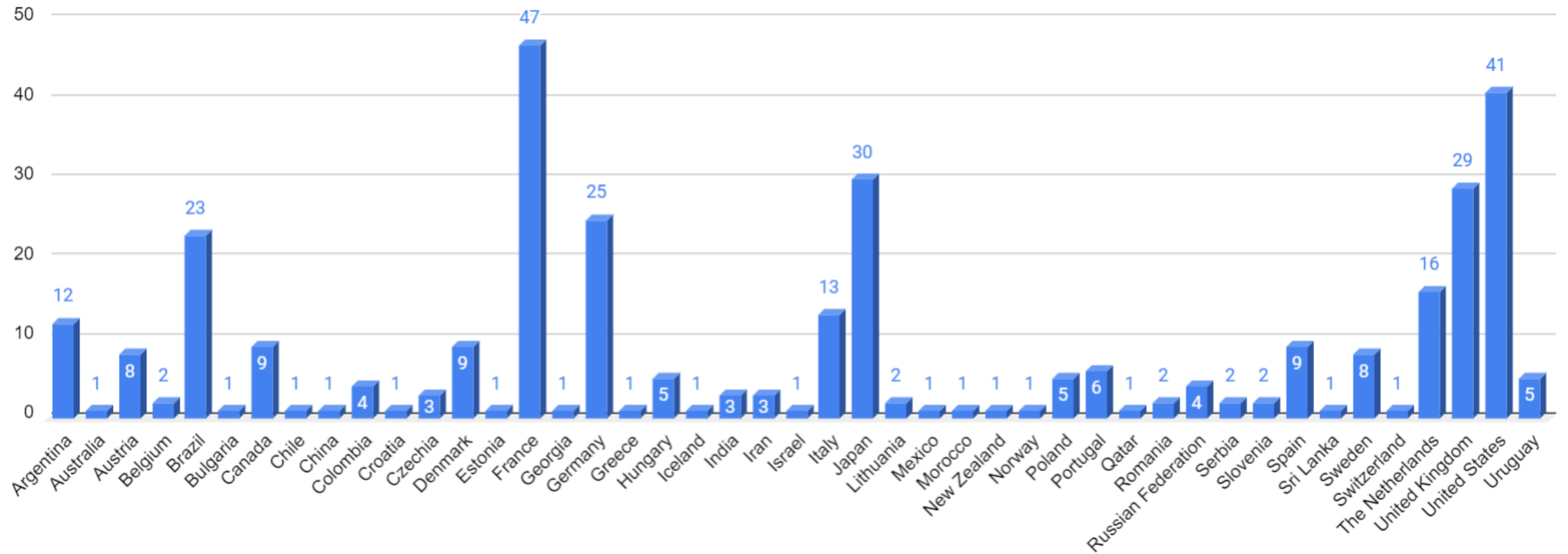
Declared days of participation



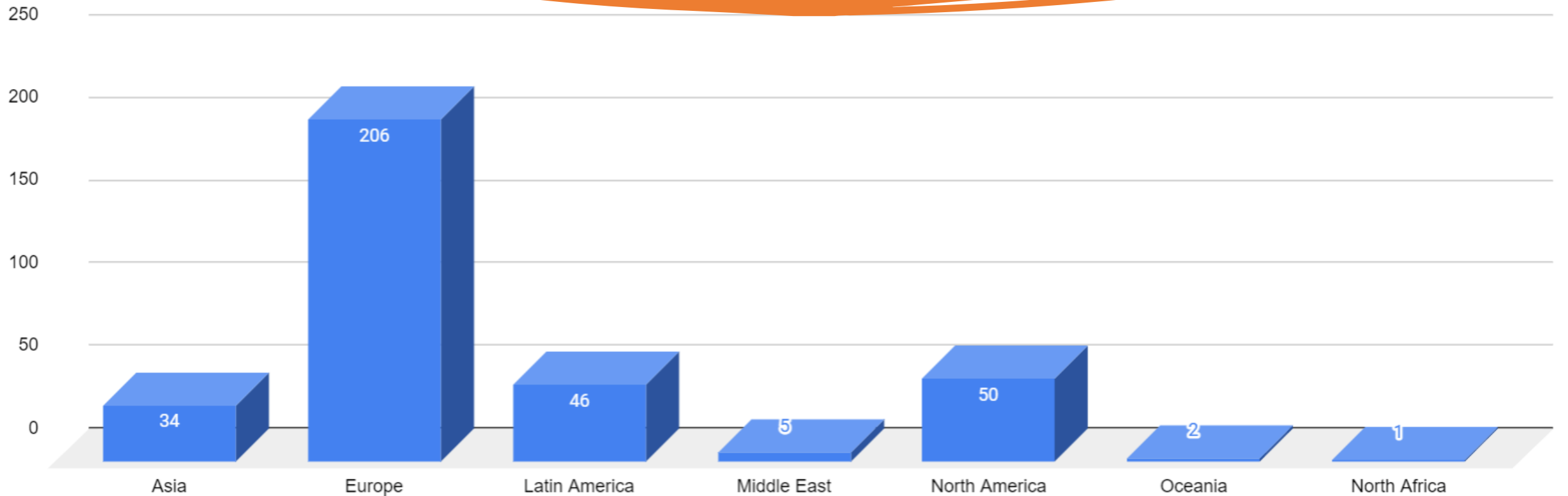
Participation per country

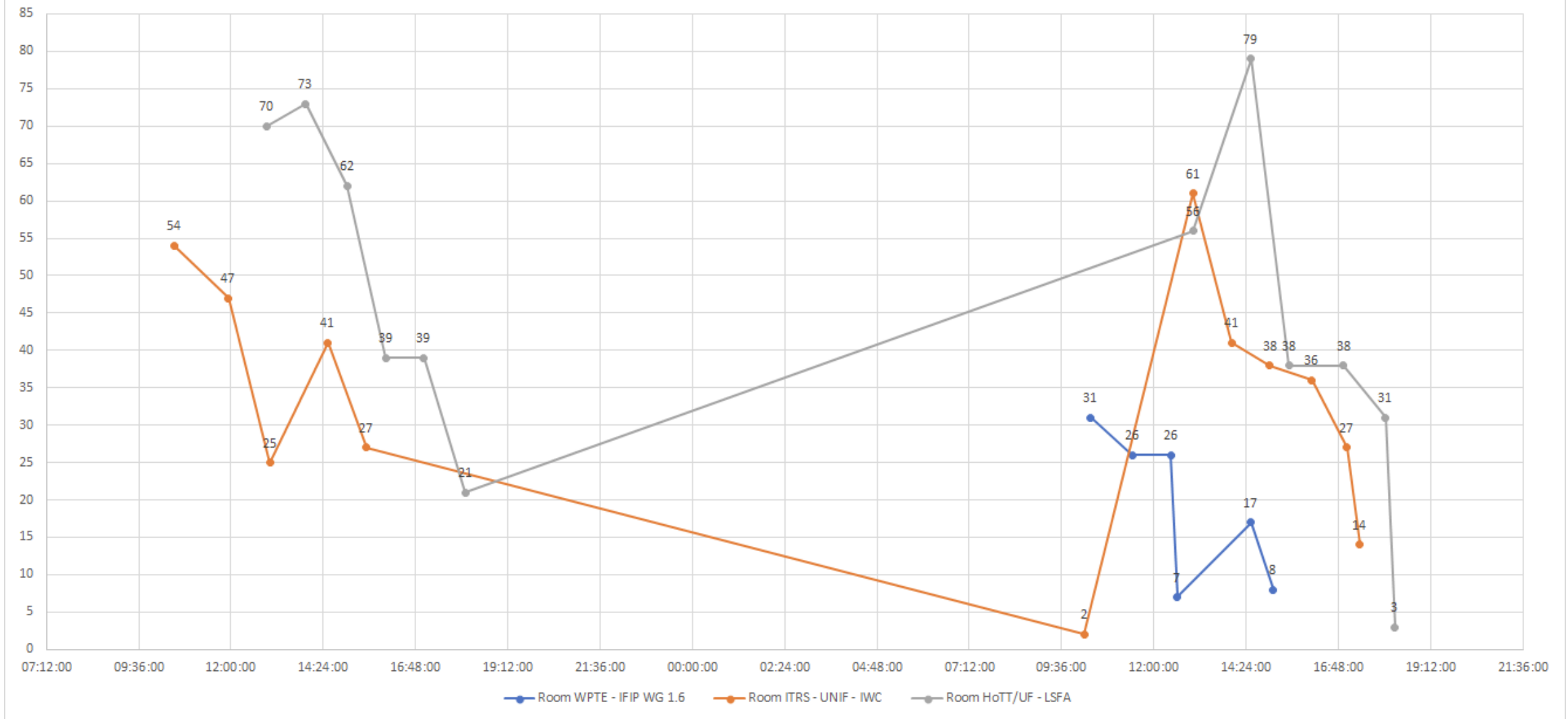


Participation per country
