FSCD Account



- Opened in 2020.
- Hosted by the French Centre National de la Recherche Scientifique (CNRS).
- Needs a special agreement between CNRS and the paying institution.
- Can pay usual expenses (but not of all them, e.g. awards).
- Can be used in the future for different purposes.

FSCD Who's Who



- File shared by the FSCD steering committee.
- Around 400 people (including 2021).
- Historical information about PC members, invited speakers, authors, steering committee members, etc.
- Important to maintain: useful working tool for the SC (e.g. future core (re)submission) and the PC chairs.

Core Ranking

- CORE= Computing Research and Education Association of Australasia
- The CORE Conference Ranking provides assessments of major conferences in the computing disciplines.
- The rankings are managed by the CORE Executive Committee. Ranking coordinator: Lin Padgham.
- Call for submissions: November 2020, deadline: 30th December 2020
- Submission: FSCD asked rank A
- Result: unranked:NEW
- Justification: This conference made a submission to be added at rank A. This is a new conference which grew out of a merger between 2 other conferences, one of which was RTA, previously ranked A. The other was not ranked in CORE. It was considered not possible to get sufficient data at this stage to establish it as an A and it was felt better to tag this as unranked: NEW which is reserved for conferences that have started within the last 5 years, in order to allow time for data to accumulate.
- Next deadline: unknown

FSCD Workshop Scheduling Committee



- This is a new committee.
- Constitution: representatives of all the FSCD SC workshops, FSCD local workshop chair(s), SC workshop chair.
- Goal: structure the FSCD pre-workshops and post-workshops, avoid overlaps, agree on the schedule, share invited speakers, etc.
- Needs an assessment to understand what can be improved for next years.
