- Final version: May 6, 2024 (not changed)

Final version format:

„For the final version, there is a page limit of 20 pages for the main body (excluding bibliography).

If you want to have appendices the number of pages of main body and appendices together is limited to 20 pages.“

# Reviewing

- 2 papers had 5 reviews
- 17 papers had 4 reviews
- 38 papers had 3 reviews
  
- PC members were in sum assigned between 4 and 10 papers (the one case of 4 was special)  
with reviews/PC =  $192/28 = 6.85$
  
- Reviews were of very high quality
  
- Reviewing process collegial and constructive
  
- Rebuttal phase was important
