- ▶ central location
- ▶ walking distance to many hotels, cafeterias, pubs, restaurants, parks, other attractions (zoo, theaters, cinemas, opera, etc.)
- ▶ five minutes by public transport or 40 minutes by foot to the city center (old town and Freedom Square  $\approx$  3 km away)

# Tbilisi, Georgia

Tbilisi is the capital and largest city of Georgia  
(<https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Tbilisi>).

Tbilisi International Airport is 15 km away from the city.

Direct connections to more than 30 destinations in Europe, Asia, Middle East.

From the airport, the city can be reached by bus (1 GEL, 0.3 EUR) or by taxi (approx. 35 GEL, 10 EUR).

Public transportation is very cheap in Tbilisi:

- ▶ Minibus, bus, subway cost 1 GEL (0.3 EUR).
- ▶ Taxi costs at most 20 GEL (6 EUR) in Tbilisi between any two locations inside the city.
