Dates and set-up

- ▶ Joint conference FSCD-CADE (like in 2023 in Rome)

Where

- ▶ Van der Valk hotel and conference centre in Nijmegen-Lent
- ▶ Very good large lecture halls and equipment, well-organised
- ▶ Provides accommodation as well
- ▶ Has a small train station, well reachable by car and public transport
- ▶ On Walking/cycling distance from Nijmegen centre and other hotel locations



Reachability of Nijmegen



- ▶ By plane:
 - ▶ Amsterdam-Schiphol and then 1hr. 30 min. train to Nijmegen
 - ▶ Eindhoven airport and then 1hr. 30 min. bus+train (Barcelona, Valencia, Lisbon, Oslo, Budapest, London STN)
 - ▶ Düsseldorf-Weeze and then 1hr. bus (Ryanair, e.g. Edinburgh)
- ▶ By train:

From Brussels 3 hr	From Duisburg 3 hr	From Berlin 7 hr
From Paris 5 hr	From London 5.5 hr	

Costs

- ▶ Hotels in Nijmegen: start from about 120 E per night for a week. Van der Valk is 150 E per night without breakfast. There are various cheaper options, in particular if you want to share a room.
- ▶ Registration Fees: hard to estimate for 2027. How we see it now:
 - ▶ 750 E all-in, for 2 Conferences + Workshops, including: coffee breaks + lunches + welcome reception + social event + conference diner
 - ▶ We will have early/late registration fees
 - ▶ Special fees for students
 - ▶ Workshop only fees
